ICC WORLD CRICKET LEAGUE



The top five teams from the ICC Trophy Ireland 2005 in order Scotland, Ireland, Canada, Bermuda and the Netherlands, will join Kenya in the top tier of the newly introduced ICC World Cricket League in an initiative that will bring regular global one-day cricket to the top 18 non-Full Member countries. The first tournament will be held in Nairobi, Kenya.
